I. Shenzhen (18/9 - 19/9)

Shenzhen, often dubbed the "Silicon Valley of China," is a vibrant metropolis nestled in the southern Guangdong Province with 13 million population. Shenzhen boasts a staggering GDP that consistently ranks among the highest in China, exceeding 3 trillion yuan (over 450 billion USD). This immense economic output stems from its thriving tech industry, manufacturing, and international trade. It's no surprise that Shenzhen is home to some of China's largest and most influential companies, including Huawei, Tencent, and DJI.



II. Shanghai (20/9)

Shanghai is often hailed as the nation's financial nucleus. With a population exceeding 24 million, it's a bustling city where tradition and modernity harmoniously coexist. Shanghai's economic might is evident in its consistently robust GDP, surpassing 3.5 trillion yuan (over 520 billion USD). Shanghai is the proud host to the headquarters of influential corporations like Alibaba, SAIC Motor, and China Eastern Airlines.



III. Jiaxing (21/9 - 22/9)

Nestled in the heart of eastern China, Jiaxing presents itself as a serene and charming city with its unique allure. Despite its smaller scale in comparison to colossal metropolises like Shenzhen and Shanghai, Jiaxing, with a population of approximately 5 million (with a GDP of 100 billion USD), has a story to tell. Jiaxing's strength lies in its manufacturing capabilities, especially in textiles and garments. The city also specializes in automotive and boating parts.

IV. Ningbo (23/9-24/9)

Situated along China's eastern coast, Ningbo stands as a thriving city, Ningbo boasts an impressive GDP, consistently ranking among China's highest, surpassing 1.4 trillion yuan (around 216 billion USD). This economic might is driven by a diverse range of industries, including manufacturing, trade, finance, and technology. Ningbo is home to several influential companies, including Ningbo Haitian Group, a leading manufacturer of condiments and food additives, and Zhejiang Geely Holding Group, one of China's largest automotive manufacturers.



V. Hefei (23/9-24/9)

Hefei, nestled in eastern China's Anhui Province, Hefei's GDP has seen remarkable growth, exceeding 1.1 trillion yuan (around 170 billion USD) in recent years. This economic dynamism stems from a diverse industrial landscape, including electronics, automotive, and pharmaceuticals. Hefei is home to several influential companies, including Hefei Meiling Co., Ltd., a major home appliance manufacturer. JAC Motors, an automotive giant, also has its headquarters in the city



VI. Qingdao (27/9-28/9)

Nestled along the picturesque shores of the Yellow Sea, Qingdao boasts a robust GDP that has consistently placed it among China's economically prominent cities, surpassing 1.2 trillion yuan (approximately 185 billion USD). Key drivers include manufacturing, shipping, finance, and technology. Qingdao is home to several influential companies, including Haier Group, a global leader in home appliances, and Hisense Group, renowned for its electronics and appliances
